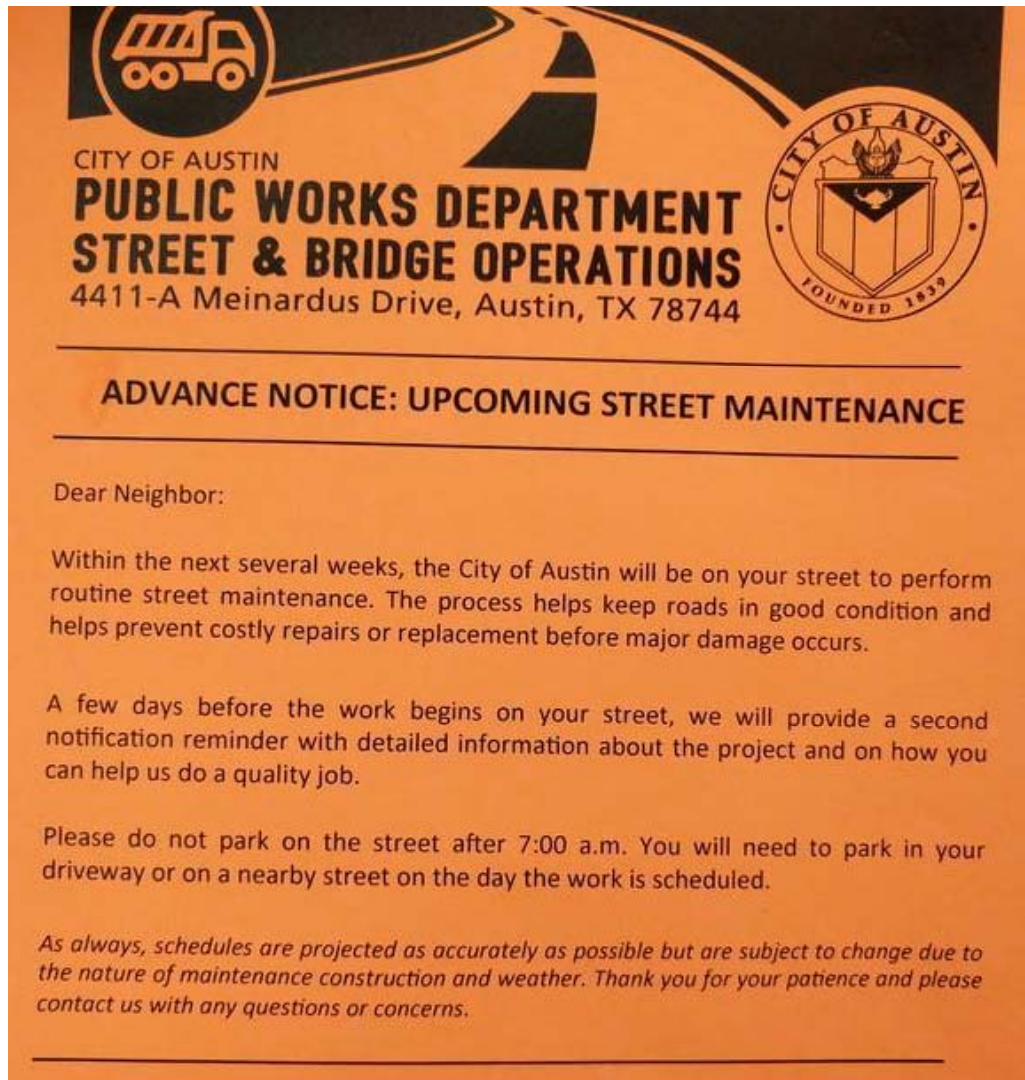

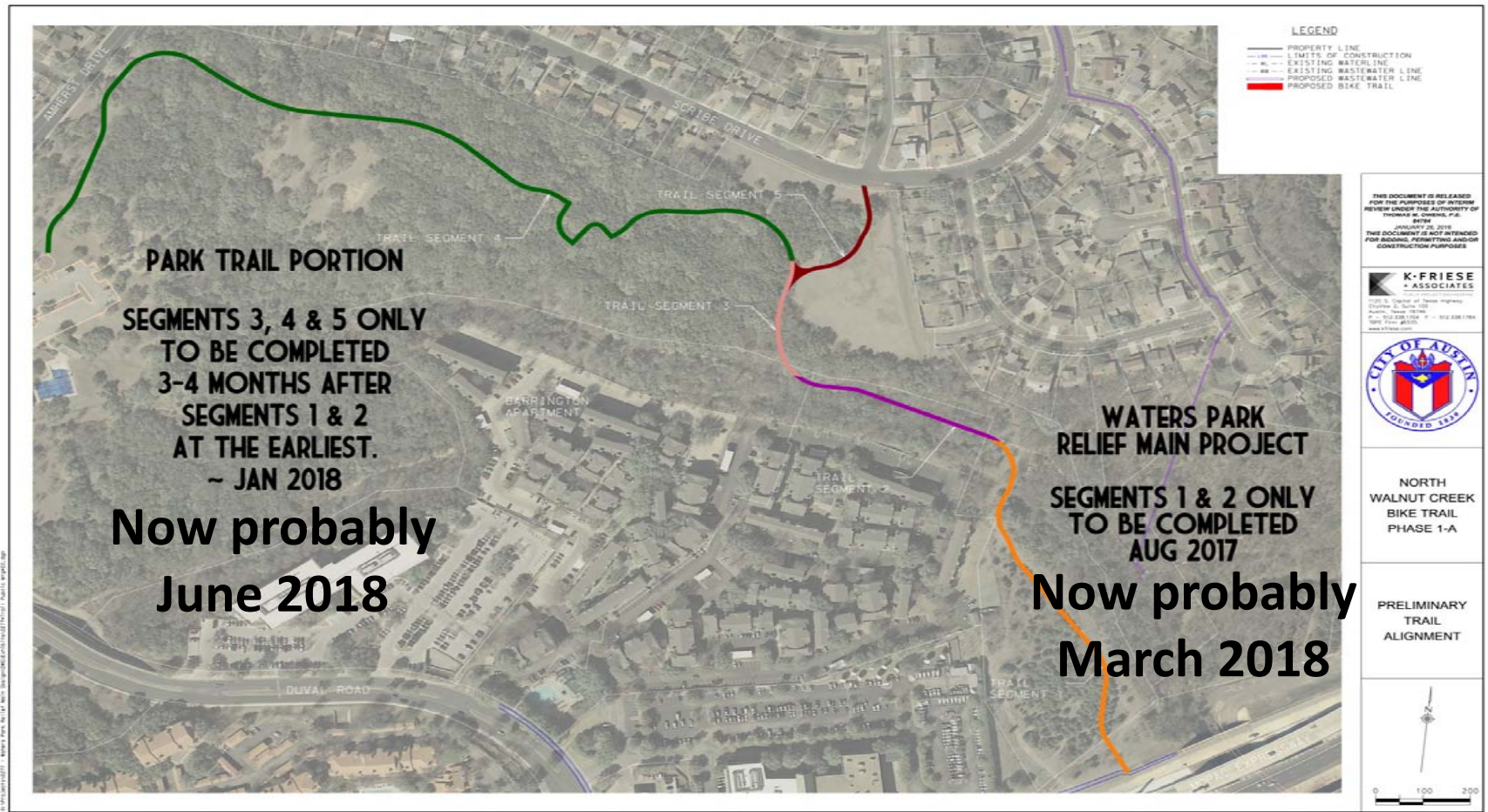


Northern Walnut Creek Trail & Waste Water Project Updates

Our Asks:

- A better option to a low water crossing has been granted.
- Improved Trail Design – a switchback to minimize slope
- Tree Mitigation Concerns are being addressed
- Shortened Timeline:
 - Switchback Section of Trail at 90% design. Should begin early 2018. We have asked for sooner.
 - Waters Park Relief Main Portion of Trail to be completed in 18 months from Sept 2016. On schedule.

Trail Update



Creekside Trail Repair NPP Grant APPROVED!!

Project:

- Repair 300 feet of washouts, potholes, & gaps within 2,200 feet of trail
- Protect the Bluffs & Endangered Jollyville Salamander Habitat
- Clear the 70 ft of Rock out of the Creek to reset the Creek's Course
- Estimated Cost of \$117,000.
- Our Promise is 1,522 volunteer hours in the next 2 years and \$9,302 in the next 6 months! We have already raised almost \$2,000!

*Once these trail sections are repaired and Northern Walnut Creek Trail Completed it would create a 1.2 mile loop in Balcones Park.

Trail Clean-up on Earth Day at Balcones Park



- The Friends of Balcones Park are teaming with Austin Parks Foundation to do an Earth Day project on April 22, Saturday, 9am-12noon.
- Priority 1 -finish clearing debris from the “creekside” trail in the park/greenbelt. This work will count towards our grant for repairing the chuckholes in the trail.
- If we get done, or have lots of people, we will move down to the creek/greenbelt by Mopac and clean trash.

Batteries, Oil, Paint & Antifreeze Collection Event on Sat. May 6th

- **Start gathering those leftover paint cans, used oil and oil filters, dead batteries, antifreeze and clean, dry styrofoam & plastic film.**

- We are allowed to only collect: Batteries, Oil, Latex Paint, and Antifreeze.
- We will not be accepting other household hazardous wastes including: oil-based paint, paint thinner or stripper, cleaning chemicals, pool chemicals, pesticides, or light bulbs.

Styrofoam Collection Year Round

- We have a generous neighbor who will accept Styrofoam and bring it to the Resource Recovery Center since it can't go in the Blue Recycling Bins and ideally wouldn't be placed in the trash bins either.
- Simply make sure it is clean and dry then place it in a plastic bag on the porch at **12011 Trianon Ln**

What kinds of plastic foam are accepted?

What *is* accepted:

- Plastic foam made from polystyrene - commonly found in egg cartons, food packaging, meat trays, to-go containers, disposable plates and coffee cups, foam ice chests and in shipping and packaging materials.
- Plastic foam made from polyethylene, commonly used in shipping and packing items such as electronics

What *is not* accepted:

- Packing peanuts or soft foam, such as the foam typically found in mattress pads
- Plastic foam that is attached or glued to other materials, like cardboard or plastic film
